



Only use the OPAL Transit Wheelchair for its intended purpose which is as a short term usage mobile chair for a single user that is operated by an attendant / carer.





Ensure you have been supplied with the following parts:

OPERATION - UNFOLDING / FOLDING WHEELCHAIR

The OPAL Transit Wheelchair comes folded and requires unfolding prior to use.

Please follow these steps:


- 1. Pull **OUT** on both of the armrests at the same time to open out the wheelchair.
- 2. Push down on the outside edges of seat to ensure wheelchair has been fully unfolded.


Important note:

DO NOT place fingers underneath seat when unfolding wheelchair!

To fold wheelchair:

- Pull **UP** on front & back of seat.
 - Ensure footplates are up prior to folding
 - Ensure seat is flipped up as shown.






OPERATION - UNFOLDING / FOLDING BACKREST

The OPAL Transit Wheelchair comes with the folded backrest and requires unfolding prior to use.


Please follow these steps:

- 1. Place your hand on the armrest.
- 2. Rotate up each backrest handle until it locks into position.




Important note:

Check to ensure both backrest handles have locked into position prior to use. (Loud `CLICK' should be heard)



OPERATION - FIT / REMOVE SWING AWAY FOOTRESTS

OPERATION - FOOTREST

The OPAL Transit Wheelchair comes with adjustable height swing up footplates.


Both the footplates should be in the up position when the wheelchair is unoccupied.

Rotate the footplates down once the occupant is sitting in the wheelchair.


IMPORTANT NOTE:

Ensure the footplates are in the up position when folding the wheelchair.

The footplates can be adjusted in height if required. Using the allen key supplied undo the bolt and remove from footplate. Re position the footplate at required height, line up holes, insert bolt and tighten.

OPERATION - BRAKES

The OPAL Transit Wheelchair comes with attendant operated hand brakes located on the push handles and rear wheels.

To ENGAGE BRAKE:

PARTIALLY pull up on lever. (Brake will disengage when lever is released)

To ENGAGE PARK BRAKE:

FULLY pull up on lever until a loud `CLICK' is heard. (Brake will remain engaged when lever is released)

Note:

It is recommended that the park brake is NOT engaged when not required.

To **DIS-ENGAGE PARK BRAKE**:

Pull up on small lever. (Park brake will disengage when lever is released)


The hand brakes above the rear wheels can also be used as a park brake.


Push lever forward to engage park brake.


Pull lever back to release park brake.

USER GUIDELINES - SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Please follow these guidelines to get the optimal benefit from the OPAL Transit Wheelchair. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in damage to the wheelchair and put the user at risk.

The OPAL Transit Wheelchair is designed to take 136kg Maximum Load. Do not overload the wheelchair!

The footplates are not designed to be load bearing. Do not stand on the footplates when getting on or off the wheelchair.

Always engage the park brakes when user is getting on or off the wheelchair.

Go up or down inclines directly. Do not try to cross on an angle as this will cause instability and wheelchair may tip over.

IMPORTANT NOTE


The OPAL Transit Wheelchair is NOT APPROVED to transport the user whilst in a vehicle. The user must stow the wheelchair and transfer to a seat with approved restraints.

When manoeuvring the wheelchair over a step the attendant should push down with their foot on the outrigger at rear of wheelchair and push down on both handles to raise the front wheels.

The occupant of the wheelchair must not lean too far to one side or lean backwards causing the wheels to leave the ground.

PRODUCT CARE - INSPECTIONS / CLEANING

INSPECTIONS

We suggest that you visually check the OPAL Transit Wheelchair periodically for signs of damage or wear prior to use, paying particular attention to the following areas:

Framework – check for damage or distortion.

Wheels - check to ensure wheelchair rolls as required

Brakes - check to ensure both brakes work as required (handle brakes and wheel brakes)

Seat / Backrest / Hand grips / Armrests - check for cracks / tears in material

Overall check that no components are loose or worn and the wheelchair operates as required.



Withdraw the OPAL Transit Wheelchair from use immediately if you suspect damage or any other fault. If in any doubt, please do not issue or use, but immediately contact your supplier for service support.

CLEANING

Clean the OPAL Transit Wheelchair using a non-abrasive cleaner or mild detergent with a soft cloth.

Abrasive cleaners or abrasive cleaning pads could damage the wheelchair and should not be used.

WARRANTY

REDGUM Brand OPAL Transit Wheelchair is covered by a 12 month warranty from the date of purchase.

During the guarantee period, if the company is satisfied there is a genuine fault, we will repair or replace the product at our earliest convenience. There may be freight charges if product needs to be returned to your place of purchase.

In order for this guarantee to be valid, you must:

- Be the original purchaser
- Provide a copy of the original invoice.
- Comply with manufacturer care and maintenance instructions.

If the product has any manufacturing faults during this period contact the place of purchase for assessment. Failures as a result of **ACCIDENTAL MISUSE**, **MODIFICATION OR WEAR AND TEAR ARE NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY.**

Do not modify the OPAL Transit Wheelchair in any way or fit any parts or accessories that are not specified as a option for the wheelchair. To do so will void your warranty and may seriously compromise your safety.




